



2012 Ford Explorer and Ford Edge: SYNC with MyFord

SYNC® with MyFord™ driver connect technology blends the voice-activated connectivity features of SYNC with two vibrant, simple screen displays and five-way steering wheel controls to create a vehicle interface experience that is informative, user-friendly and familiar. The MyFord interface enhances the SYNC experience with a 4.2-inch LCD color screen in the instrument cluster and another centrally located in the center stack that help drivers easily access the information they need while keeping their hands on the wheel and eyes on the road.

SYNC is standard on 2012 Ford Explorer XLT and Ford Edge SEL, and optional on Explorer base model and Edge SE.

MyFord instrument cluster screen

Located in the center of the instrument cluster, this screen is controlled by the left control pad on the steering wheel and provides display for:

- Trip odometer
- Distance to empty
- Navigation route guidance
- Vehicle settings including MyKey
- Speed control settings

MyFord information screen

Located in the instrument panel center stack, this screen is controlled by the right control pad on the steering wheel and provides:

- Phone information such as caller ID
- Song title and artist displays
- AM/FM and Sirius channel information

Standard SYNC connectivity includes:

- Hands-free, voice-activated command and control of mobile phones and digital music players
- 911 Assist
- Vehicle Health Report
