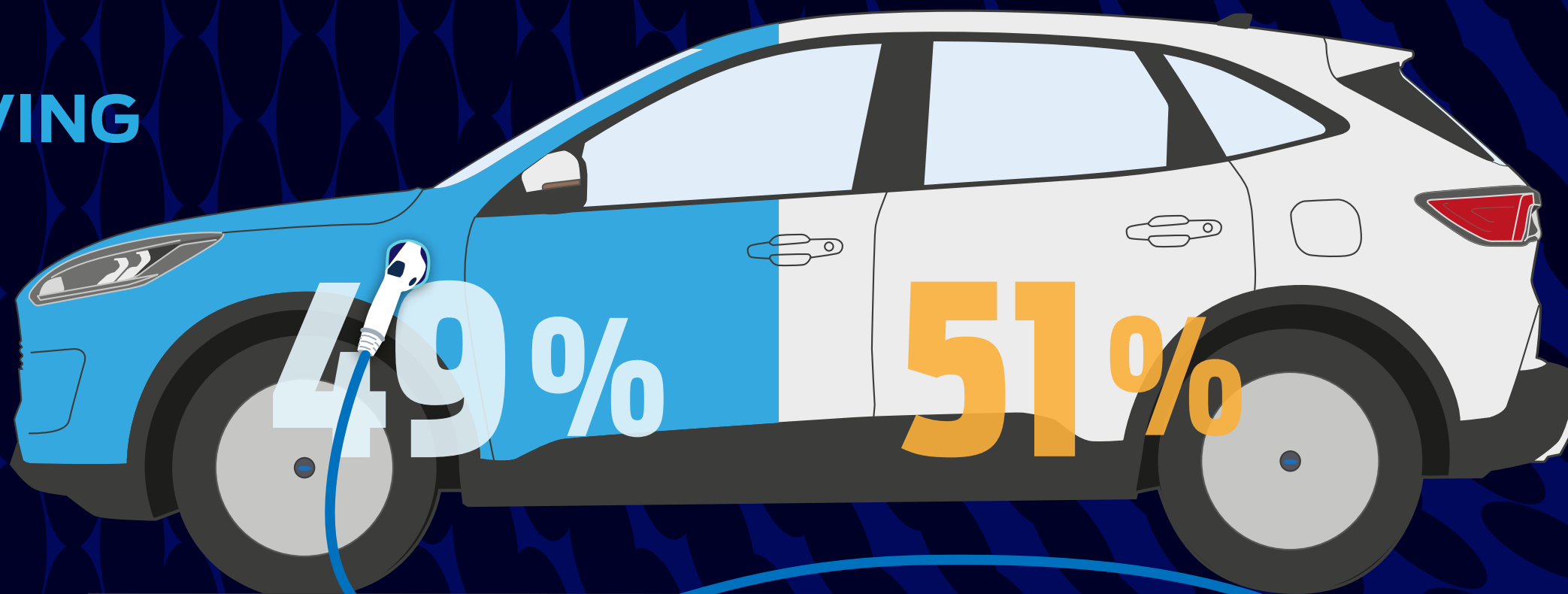


How Far Do Kuga Plug-In Hybrid Drivers Travel On Electricity Alone?

Kuga Plug-In Hybrid drivers have covered **49 per cent** of their distance travelled this year on externally-charged electricity.



TIME SPENT PLUGGED IN



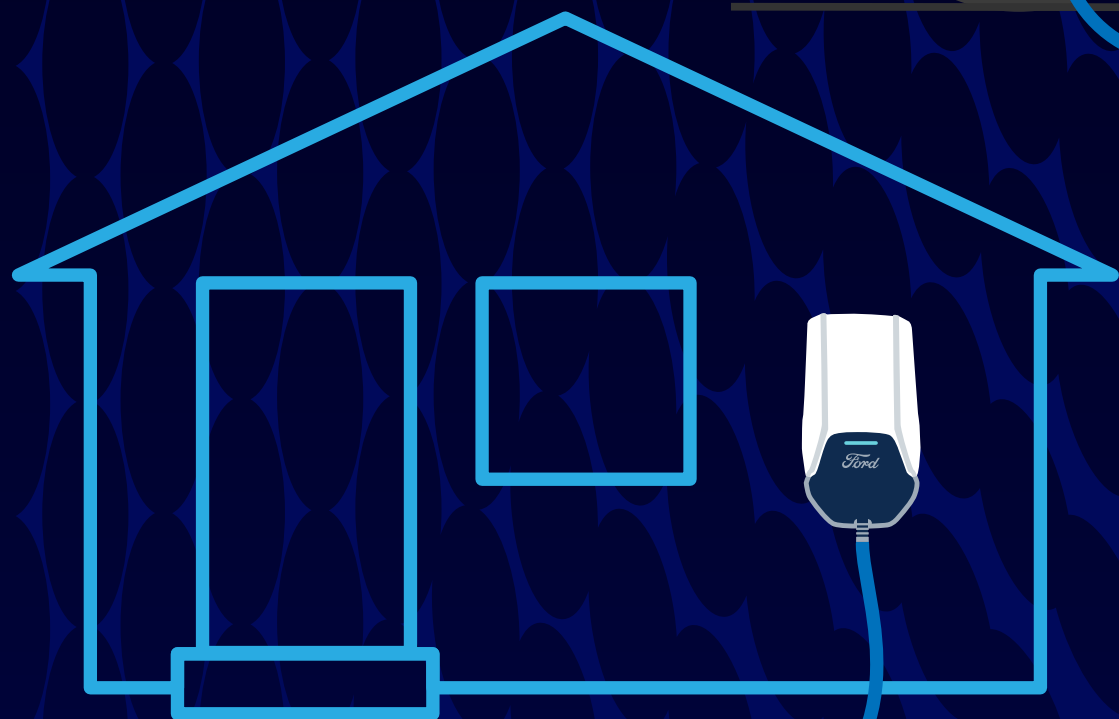
For every 100 drive days in a Kuga Plug-In Hybrid, there were **89 charging events**.



45 per cent of charging events took place overnight.



35 per cent of charging events took place overnight with a plug-in time of **12 hours or more**.



PURE-ELECTRIC RANGE

More than **420,000** Kuga Plug-In Hybrid drive days this year each covered less than 50 km and could potentially have been completed using externally-charged electricity alone.
