

# AIRBAG INNOVATION

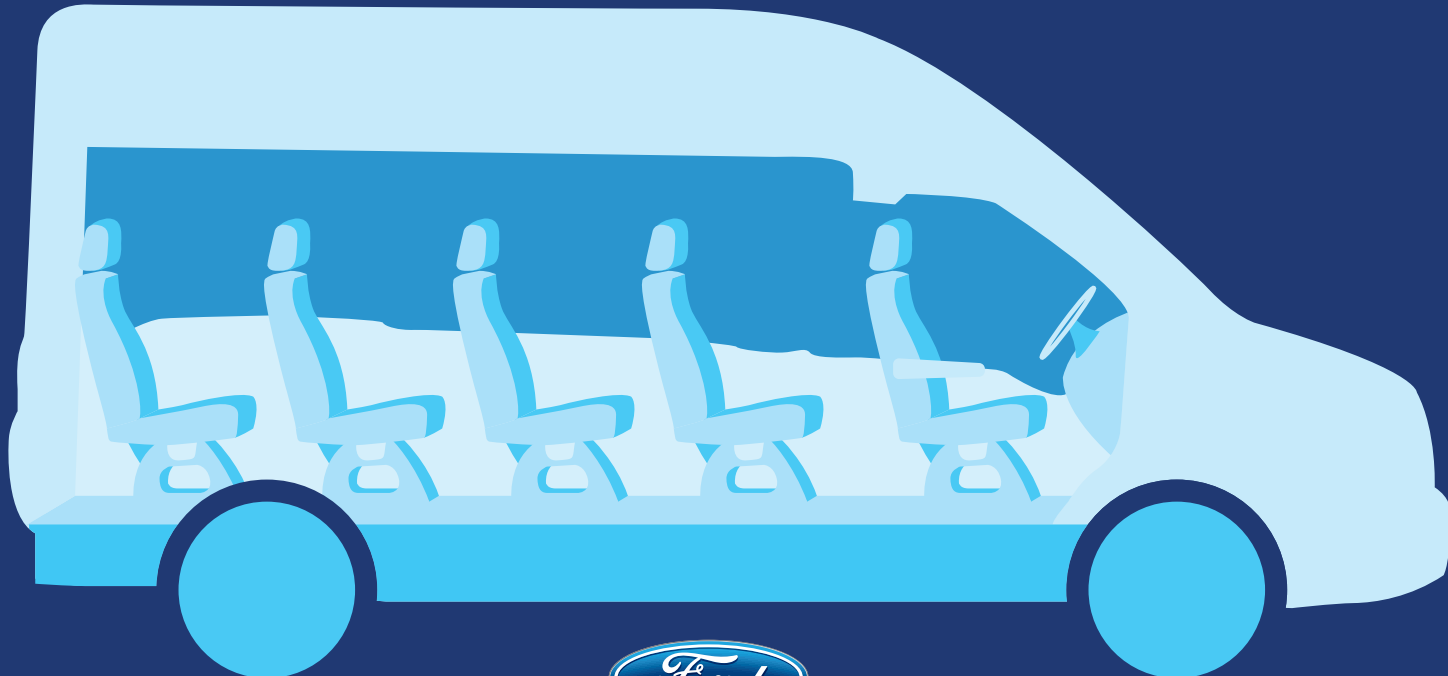
Ford, in cooperation with TRW Automotive, developed the industry's first five-row side-curtain airbag as part of the Ford Safety Canopy System<sup>®</sup> to provide enhanced head and neck protection in the event of a side-impact or rollover crash. At close to 15 feet long and three feet tall, the airbag makes its debut in the all-new Ford Transit 15-passenger wagon.

Sensors detect an impact and trigger inflators, filling the entire airbag with gas in a fraction of a second

The airbag is made of a coated, polyester-based fabric that holds the gas, so the bag remains inflated for several seconds

Designed to provide enhanced head and neck protection in the event of a side impact or rollover crash as part of Ford's Safety Canopy<sup>®</sup> System

Other standard safety features for Transit wagon include front and front-seat side airbags for the driver and front passenger, three-point safety belts for all seats, AdvanceTrac<sup>®</sup> with Roll Stability Control<sup>™</sup> and SOS Post-Crash Alert System<sup>™</sup>
